

**GUARANTEE BY SURETIES FOR PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE ON SEALING OF
GRANT OF PROBATE OR LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION ISSUED IN ANOTHER
COUNTRY**

2. The giving of time to the said CD or any other forbearance or indulgence shall not in
any way affect our liability under this guarantee.

3. The liability under this guarantee shall be continuing and shall be for the whole amount of the loss mentioned in paragraph 1 above but our aggregate total liability shall not in any event exceed the sum of Kenya Shillings (K.Sh.).
